
Wire Drop Compensator




Dynamically Compensate for Voltage Drop Between Power Supply and Load

The LT6110 operates on supply voltages from 2V to 50V, and controls standard feedback regulators and "current source" reference devices, such as Linear Technology's LT3080. This tiny, low cost device ensures worry-free connection from power supply to load.
