



This scope of the startup guide is to introduce you to Waveform Creator software and describe the process of Installing and licensing the product. It also enclose details on how to quickly get started with the software.



#### 1. Introduction

M9099 Waveform Creator provides a modular and flexible waveform creation environment supporting analog and digital modulation formats for the <u>Agilent M9381A Vector Signal Generator</u> for R&D, design validation, and test engineers who need to create and manage custom waveforms for wireless and high speed wireline product design & testing.

Waveform Creator provides a simple, easy, & modular SW framework for creating, combining & managing custom, arbitrary waveforms, with support for corrected waveform download to Agilent AWGs and Signal Generators. It accelerates design validation and testing of chips, modules, and systems by streamlining development and management of custom stimulus waveforms.



Waveform Creator provides various benefits out of the box:

- Flexible waveform creation and generation capability for Agilent M9381 PXI VSG.
- Standard waveform plug-ins for of general-purpose waveform creation.
- Optional waveform creation plug-in for basic digital modulation (-AYA).
- Optional waveform creation plug-in for SystemVue simulation models.
- Optional waveform generation plug-in (-DFW) for writing unencrypted waveform files (CSV, MAT, M9381A and BIN).
- User extendable functionality such as creating your own waveform input plug-ins.
- SCPI remote control for test automation.

# 3. Installing Waveform Creator

Follow the given steps to get the executable and install Agilent M9099 Waveform Creator software (core and plug-ins) on your system.

#### 3.1. Pre-requisites

A host PC with <u>Agilent IO Libraries Suite</u> software correctly installed: For more details, refer to Summary of Software/Hardware Compatibility with Waveform Creator section under <u>System Requirements</u>.


#### 3.2. Obtain Waveform Creator Executable

Obtain the Waveform Creator executable from the following sources:

- A.com<sup>a</sup>
- CD-ROM (Product ordered with -MED option)

#### 3.3. Install Waveform Creator Core

1. Double-click the executable (*Agilent M9099 Setup.exe*) to run the Waveform Creator setup. The following screen appears:




2. Follow the guided tour to complete the installation.

# 3.4. Install Plug-ins

1. The InstallShield Wizard installs the Agilent M9099 Waveform Creator plug-in on your computer.



2. Click Next to continue.



- 3. Select the features you want to install and click **Next** to install in the default folder.
- 4. Follow the guided tour to complete the installation

# 4. Setting Up Licenses

This section describes Agilent software licensing and the licenses required to run the Agilent Waveform Creator software.

#### 4.1. Agilent Software Licensing

The Waveform Creator software supports Node-Locked licensing type.

For more details on different license types and setup, launch **Agilent License**Manager from **Start** > **All Programs** > **Agilent License Manager** or by clicking 

from system tray.

When you purchase Waveform Creator, you are provided with a License Redemption Entitlement Certificate that documents the options to which you are entitled. You can redeem the certificate at <a href="http://www.agilent.com/find/softwaremanager">http://www.agilent.com/find/softwaremanager</a> using the purchase order number, entitlement certificate number, and other details to run the software.

The Agilent Software Licensing system issues a license file for each purchased option, by email, to an address you specify. Each license file is a plain text file attachment with a file name in the form XXXXXX\_YYYYYY.lic.

When you receive the e-mail, you should save the attached .lic file(s) to the Agilent license directory, which is, by default, located at C:\Program Files\Agilent\licensing.

#### Note

You can check the status of your software licenses by running the optional Agilent License Manager or by selecting **Help** > **About...** from the Waveform Creator menu and then selecting the Licenses tab in the About dialog.

If a license is not available or not valid, the corresponding features will not be enabled by the Agilent Waveform Creator.

#### 5. Quick Start

This section introduces a typical Waveform Creator workflow. You will create a test modulation in M9099 Waveform Creator, download it to the M9381A Vector Signal Generator (VSG), and verify the resulting RF signal using the N9020A MXA Signal Analyzer.

This should be sufficient to get you familiar with the basic workflow.

- Configure the System
- Create a Simple Waveform
- Download the Waveform

### **5.1. Configure the System**

#### **5.2. Create a Simple Waveform**

Waveforms are created by dragging and dropping waveform segments from the active Segment Library window into the Waveform Layout window. Once the desired sequence of waveform segments is achieved, the composite waveform, including any added noise or other impairments, can be reviewed in the Output Device window.

Follow these steps to create a simple waveform:

- 1. Run the M9099 Waveform Creator software.
- 2. Select the Multi-tone Segment Library tab.
- 3. Drag and drop Segment 1 from the Segment Library window into the Waveform Layout window by selecting the colored box numbered 1.

  The Multi-tone Segment 1 panel appears on the left.
- 4. Change the segment 1 settings to the following (leave all others at their default values):
  - a. Tone Type: Single Tone
  - b. Tone Frequency: 60.00 MHz
  - c. Tone Modulation Symbol Rate: 10.00 MHz
  - d. Tone Modulation Type: 16 QAM

e. Tone Filter Type: Root Raised-Cosine

f. Tone Filter BT/Shape: 0.300

g. Tone Minimum Length: 65536

#### Note

Waveforms can also be imported in the form of CSV HDF and BIN file format using File Import plug-in. To import:

- 1. In the File Import Segment, under **Main Settings**, set the **Waveform Type** to "From XXX File", where XXX=CSV, BIN or HDF.
- Specify the Waveform File Name under Segment Settings to import the desired file.

#### 5.3. Download the Waveform

Generated waveforms using Waveform Creator can be downloaded either to an output device like M9381A or File (csv, matlab or binary format).

#### 5.3.1. M9381A VSG

To download waveform on an M9381A VSG:

- 1. Connect the M9099 Waveform Creator to the M9381A Vector Signal Generator
- 2. Run M9099 software
- 3. Generate Output

#### 5.3.2. Connect the M9099 Waveform Creator to the M9381A Vector Signal Generator

The Agilent M9381A VSG hardware comprises four interconnected PXIe modules, typically hosted in an Agilent M9018A PXIe chassis. These modules must be controlled over the PXIe bus by the M9381A instrument driver in order to deliver the product functionality. The driver may be hosted by an embedded controller PC in the same PXIe chassis, or by an external laptop or desktop PC whose PCIe backplane has been extended (by adapters and cable) onto the backplane of the PXIe chassis. The possible configurations are fully described in the *Agilent M9381A Configuration Guide (5991-0897EN)*.

Once the M9381A hardware is configured and the M938x VSG/CW Source Instrument Driver is installed, other applications (such as M9099) may communicate with the M9381A by means of IVI-COM driver calls to the VISA PXI address assigned to the M9381A in the Agilent IO Libraries Suite.

#### 5.3.3. Generate Output

To generate output:

- 1. Select Generate > Output Device > Agilent M9381A VSG to select the output device.
- 2. Select the Current Output Device Settings window and change the device settings to the following (leave all other parameters at their default values):
  - a. Instrument Address: <VISA string from Agilent IO Libraries>
  - b. Frequency: 1.5 GHz
  - c. Amplitude: 0 dBm
  - d. RF On: True
- 3. Click the Generate and Output button in the <u>tool bar</u> to send the created waveform to M9381A VSG.

If you have no M9381A hardware installed (and therefore have no address to enter), you can still explore the software functionality by changing the M9381A output device setting Simulation to **True**. In this mode, Settings changes and waveform downloads will appear to work, but the changes and data are simply discarded by the M9381A driver.

For more details on M9381A Output plug-in settings, refer to M9381A Output Plug-in.

#### 5.3.4. Data File Write

Waveform Creator allows you to save the output waveform to a file in either of the following formats:

- CSV (comma separated)
- N5110A waveform (\*.bin)
- MATLAB® Level 5 MAT-File

To download waveform to a file:

- 1. Select **Generate** > **Output Device** > \*File (csv, binary or matlab).
- 2. Set the parameter values

3. Click the Generate and Output button in the <u>tool bar</u> to save the output to a file on the host computer.

For file data, the maximum sample rate is not limited by hardware, so for internal coding purposes a nominal limit of 5 GHz is set. Within this limit, the auto sample rate algorithm chooses the most appropriate sample rate for the generated waveform. If a higher sample rate is needed, then this nominal limit can be over-ruled by using the manual sample rate setting.

The output files are unencrypted and can be formatted in various ways to facilitate their import into other Agilent and non-Agilent tools.

For more details on File settings, refer to **Data File Write Plug-in**.

#### Note

Output to all supported Agilent VSG is standard as part of Waveform Creator functionality but file output is separately licensed as Waveform Creator option DFW.
