1. General description

The 74LVC16245A-Q100; 74LVCH16245A-Q100 is a 16-bit transceiver with 3-state outputs. The device can be used as two 8-bit transceivers or one 16-bit transceiver. The device features two output enables (10E and 20E) each controlling eight outputs, and two send/receive (1DIR and 2DIR) inputs for direction control. A HIGH on noE causes the outputs to assume a high-impedance OFF-state. Inputs can be driven from either 3.3 V or 5 V devices. This feature allows the use of these devices as translators in mixed 3.3 V and 5 V environments.

Schmitt-trigger action at all inputs makes the circuit tolerant of slower input rise and fall times.

This device is fully specified for partial power down applications using I_{OFF} . The I_{OFF} circuitry disables the output, preventing the potentially damaging backflow current through the device when it is powered down.

This product has been qualified to the Automotive Electronics Council (AEC) standard Q100 (Grade 1) and is suitable for use in automotive applications.







Fig. 5. The input (nAn, nBn) to output (nBn, nAn) propagation delays








Fig. 8. Package outline SOT362-1 (TSSOP48)




Fig. 9. Package outline SOT480-1 (TVSOP48)
