



## **NOTE: Correct Biasing Sequence for GaN Depletion Mode Transistors**

#### Turning the device ON

- 1. Set  $V_{GS}$  to -5 V
- 2. Turn on  $V_{DS}$  to nominal supply voltage (48 V)
- 3. Increase V<sub>GS</sub> until I<sub>DS</sub> current is attained
- 4. Apply RF input power to desired level

## **Turning the device OFF**

- 1. Turn RF power off
- 2. Reduce  $V_{GS}$  down to -5~V
- Reduce V<sub>DS</sub> down to 0 V (Adequate time must be allowed for V<sub>DS</sub> to reduce to 0 V to prevent severe damage to device.)
- 4. Turn off  $V_{GS}$






Figure 2. A2G22S190-01SR3 Test Circuit Component Layout
